



Social Science Standards with Literacy Connections

Intended Audience: Social Science Teachers, Curriculum Coordinators, Administrators

Description: The suggested document was created to assist social science educators in identifying cross-curricular standard connections as they implement the Illinois Social Science Standards into their curriculum.

Intended Use: The Social Science Standards with Literacy Connections document is intended to be used in a variety of ways.

1. Social Science educators can use the documents to inform of the skills that students are being exposed to in ELA classrooms. Identifying where there is an overlap in skill can allow teachers to point out to students that they may have familiarity with this skill in a different context.
2. Teachers can use this document to assist in planning lessons or units of inquiry of an interdisciplinary nature, either within the classroom or in a collaborative environment with other educators.
3. Curriculum Coordinators or School Administrators can use the documents to identify similar skills and ideas that should be implemented in various subject areas in order to better inform classroom interactions.
